
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1. Getting Started

Register for the pilot/field test at <u>the California Educator Credentialing Assessments website</u>. Select Register in the top navigation.



Then, on the Register to Test page, select the "CalAPA, CalTPA, EdSp CalTPA" tab and review the registration information provided for the pilot/field test.



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2. Create an Account

On the sign-in screen, click the link to "Create an account now."



If you have previously created an account, you may sign in using your email address and the password you established when you created the account.


3. Register


Agreement
